# THE DRAGONFLY

## Capture the fun of your very own dragonfly!

1. Punch out the dragonfly pieces and make sure to clear all the slots.
2. Take the wings and weave them through the larger slots on the head/body piece; in one slot and out the other!
3. To create the beginnings of the head, flip the dragonfly so the wings are on the bottom. Stick tab A into slot A.
4. To get the dragonfly's eyes, take the string tabs attached to the circular shapes and stick them through the small hole at the bottom. Now your head is complete!
5. To attach the tail and legs, put each set of three legs into the corresponding longer slots on the body part of the dragonfly. Then attach tabs B and C into slots B and C to complete the body.
6. Finally, put the dragonfly's tail through slot D.
7. Congratulations! You just made your very own dragonfly!
