#### **CAMPER HEALTH**

If your camper is feeling unwell, we ask that they remain home from camp. Campers are allowed to return if:

- It has been 24 hours since the resolution of fever (100.4°F or higher) without the use of fever-reducing therapies or medications. AND
- The camper has received a negative COVID-19 test or a note from a doctor indicating they do not have any known illness, AND
- The camper is not experiencing any known symptoms.

Please contact Summer Camp Staff before the camper returns to camp.

#### **MORNING CHECK-IN**

On your first morning, follow signs to the Summer Camp Check-In area. Please park in the parking areas and walk your camper(s) into Building S – The Anthony J. Natalizio Center.

Do not drop off your camper(s) until you have been checked in by Summer Camp Staff.

#### **PICK-UP PROCEDURES**

# **Pick-Up Times**

Monday-Friday: 3:30pm-4:00pm

Campers picked up after 4:00pm will be charged an additional \$5 for every 5 minutes late past the pick-up time.

# **Authorized Pick-Ups**

Anyone picking up a camper must show a valid ID AND be listed on the camper(s) authorized pick-up list. If families need to add an adult to a camper's authorized pick-up list, please contact the Summer Camp Staff before 2:00pm by calling 414-765-1970, 414-765-8625, or emailing summercamp@discoveryworld.org.

#### **Early Pick-Ups**

Early pick-ups must be requested 24 hours in advance. Early pick-ups occur at the entrance to Building S – The Anthony J. Natalizio Center.

- All early pick-ups must be scheduled to happen prior to 3:00pm.
- There is no desk at WCTC. Pick-ups must be scheduled ahead of time.

### **CANCELLATION & RESCHEDULING POLICIES**

All cancellation and rescheduling requests must be made with the Reservations Department at least **three (3) weeks** prior to the camp's scheduled start/first date. Please note that camps are sold as a package and no prorated refund will be given for days your camper does not attend.

#### Cancellations

Cancellation requests must be directed to the Reservations Department at least three (3) weeks prior to the camp's scheduled start/first date. Cancellations requests made by the three (3) week deadline will receive a refund, minus a \$75 cancellation fee, per camp. Cancellation requests made after the three (3) week deadline will NOT receive a refund.

# Rescheduling

Rescheduling requests must be directed to the Reservations Department at least three (3) weeks prior to the camp's scheduled start/first date. Rescheduling requests made by the three (3) week deadline will be granted but will incur a \$25 rescheduling fee for each camp rescheduled AND for each time rescheduled. All rescheduling requests are subject to availability. Rescheduling requests made after the three (3) week deadline will NOT be granted.

#### Minimum Attendance Threshold

Discovery World reserves the right to cancel a camp if it does not meet the minimum attendance threshold. If fewer campers register than required for a camp to take place, Discovery World will notify families at least two (2) weeks before the camp's start/first date. In these cases, families can either switch to an alternative camp for no additional fee (pending availability) or receive a full refund.

#### **BEHAVIOR**

Discovery World reserves the right to remove any camper from camp if their behavior is overly disruptive, inappropriate, creates a safety hazard, or is in violation of listed policies. In such cases, the camper will be immediately removed from camp and asked not to return; possibly for the remainder of the camp and/or the remainder of the summer. In these cases, no refunds will be given.

#### WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- A lunch each day. A prepackaged afternoon snack is provided by Discovery World for all campers. A morning snack is provided by Discovery World for 1st-3rd Grade campers.
- Closed-toe, comfortable shoes. Campers will be moving around frequently. Sneakers are the best choice.
- A reusable water bottle labeled with the camper's name. Please note that water fountains are not necessarily available. Bottled water will also be provided for campers.
- Sunscreen/hat. Some camps leave the premises and/or spend a large portion of the day outdoors. Please note that Discovery World does not provide sunscreen and staff cannot assist campers with application.
- A change of clothes (underwear, shirt, pants/shorts) for campers in 1st-3rd grade. This can be left in a camper's backpack or bag.
- Label ALL items with your camper's name.

### WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME

Discovery World makes every reasonable attempt to safeguard our campers' possessions. However, we suggest that campers leave the following personal items at home:

- · Valuable items
- Phones
- Electronic devices (tablets, video games, etc.)

Texting, cell phone use, and games distract campers from being part of the camp community, so we require that all electronic devices be turned off and stored away during camp hours, including lunch and recess times. Summer Camp Staff reserve the right to hold any phone or electronic device in a secure location until the end of the camp day. If you need to contact your camper, please call 414-765-1970 or 414-765-8625 and ask for Summer Camp Staff to be contacted.
