CAMPER HEALTH

- If your camper is feeling unwell or has a fever (100.4°F or higher), we ask that they remain home from camp.
- Campers are allowed to return if all of the below are true:
 - It has been 24 hours since symptoms have improved overall OR the camper never experienced any known symptoms, AND
 - It has been 24 hours since fever resolution without fever-reducing therapies or medications.

MORNING CHECK-IN

On your first morning, follow signs to the Summer Camp Check-In area. Please park in the parking areas and walk your camper(s) into the main entrance of Selzer-Ornst Construction Company
5400 S. 60th St., Greendale, WI.

Do not drop off your camper(s) until you have been checked in by Summer Camp Staff.

PICK-UP PROCEDURES

Pick-Up Times

Monday-Friday: 3:00pm-4:30pm

Campers picked up after 4:30pm will be charged an additional \$5 for every 5 minutes late past the pick-up time.

Authorized Pick-Ups

Anyone picking up a camper must show a valid ID AND be listed on the camper(s) authorized pick-up list. If families need to add an adult to a camper's authorized pick-up list, please contact the Summer Camp Staff before 2:00pm by calling: **414-435-2249** or **414-765-8625**, or emailing **summercamp@discoveryworld.org**.

Early Pick-Ups

Early pick-ups must be requested 24 hours in advance. Early pick-ups occur at the entrance to Selzer-Ornst Construction Company.

- All early pick-ups must be scheduled to happen prior to 2:30pm.
- Pick-ups must be scheduled ahead of time.

CANCELLATION & RESCHEDULING POLICIES

All cancellation requests must be made with the Reservations Department. Please note that camps are sold as a package and no prorated refund will be given for days your camper does not attend.

Cancellations

Cancellation requests must be directed to the Reservations Department at least thirty (30) days before the camp start date. To receive a full refund, cancellations must be made within one (1) week from the date of purchase. All other cancellations made more than thirty (30) days before the start of the camp will receive a partial refund, with an \$80 cancellation fee subtracted per camp. Cancellations made less than thirty (30) days before the camp will NOT receive a refund.

Minimum Attendance Threshold

Discovery World reserves the right to cancel a camp if it does not meet the minimum attendance threshold. If fewer campers register than required for a camp to take place, Discovery World will notify families at least two (2) weeks before the camp start date. In these cases, you can receive a full refund.

BEHAVIOR

Discovery World reserves the right to remove any camper from camp if their behavior is overly disruptive, inappropriate, creates a safety hazard, or is in violation of listed policies. In such cases, the camper will be immediately removed from camp and asked not to return; possibly for the remainder of the camp and/or the remainder of the summer. In these cases, no refunds will be given.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- **A lunch each day.** A prepackaged afternoon snack is provided by Discovery World for all campers. A morning snack is provided by Discovery World for 2nd-3rd Grade campers.
- **Closed-toe, comfortable shoes.** Campers will be moving around frequently. Sneakers are the best choice.
- **A reusable water bottle labeled with the camper's name.** Please note that water fountains are not necessarily available. Bottled water will also be provided for campers.
- **Sunscreen/hat.** Some camps spend a portion of the day outdoors. Please note that Discovery World does not provide sunscreen and staff cannot assist campers with application.
- **A change of clothes (underwear, shirt, pants/shorts) for campers in 2nd-3rd grade.** This can be left in a camper's backpack or bag.
- **Label ALL items with your camper's name.**

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME

Discovery World makes every reasonable attempt to safeguard our campers' possessions, and assume no liability for lost, stolen, or damaged items. We suggest that campers leave personal items at home, including the following:
